FAQ

Is there a fee involved if you are selected? No, all costs related to the Council will be covered by grants and other contributions. There will not be fees for Council members.

Can homeschool students apply? Yes, homeschool students are welcome to apply. Everyone is welcome. If you are homeschooled, you will need a recommendation letter from someone other than a family member who has worked directly with you.

Do I need to have transportation to the meetings and activities? Yes, you will need to have your own transportation for meetings and activities. We are not in the position to provide transportation. Please consider this when applying.

When will our monthly meetings be? The monthly meetings will be held the 3rd Tuesday evening of each month during the school year. Summer meetings will have an adjusted schedule.

Where are the meetings held? We will meet at the Art Center of the Bluegrass, 401 West Main Street, Danville

Do I need to attend every meeting? The expectation is that you attend every meeting. We understand that sometimes things come up and you must miss a meeting. The emphasis is placed on you being an active member during and outside of meetings.

Do we meet in the summer months? Yes. We expect to have an adjusted meeting schedule in the summer and a wide range of additional opportunities for involvement during the summer months.

Can I apply to the Program as a junior? As a senior? Yes, you may apply as a junior in high school or in college, even though you would only be in the program for 1.5 years. No, you are not able to apply as a senior in high school or college. Applying as a senior would only give you 6 months in the program. We feel this is not enough time.

What if my circumstances change and I cannot continue for a second year? The program is designed for members to commit to at least two years. Please consider this when applying. There will be a lot of team building and working together to build relationships - so we want students who are able to make the two-year commitment.
