Where can I park? Parking is available in the parking lot behind 401 W. Main and in front of both 401 & 409 W. Main buildings. There is 1 handicap parking space. There is also parking in downtown Danville and in the stone filled parking lot across the street.

Do you allow service dogs? Yes, service dogs are allowed at the Art Center if they are housebroken and under the handler's control while visiting us.

Do you have courtesy wheelchairs? We have one courtesy wheelchair available in the federal building. Please reserve this wheelchair by calling 859-236-4054 before your visit.

Is your museum kid friendly? Yes, everyone is welcome at the Museum and the Art Center.

Do you have a museum café? Yes, we have a café in the 409 West Main building, Murrini Café.

Can I take photos of the artwork? Yes, you may photograph the artwork, but we ask that you do not use a flash. You may not use photos for commercial purposes.

I need to take a break during my visit, where should I sit? We have seating throughout the museum and galleries.

I have sensory needs; how does your museum accommodate those needs? Our staff is happy to direct you to quiet areas during your visit should you need them. We also have sensory backpacks available upon request.
